**Rules Governing the Show - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY**

Entries in Open Class shall be made by Saunders County residents. Entries are also accepted from 4-H club members and their families who are a part of the Saunders County program, but not residents of this county.

All exhibits listed in this book are to be **ENTERED BETWEEN 5:30 p.m. and 8 p.m. on TUESDAY, JULY 26, 2011**, at the north side of the Norma Kavan Open Class Building on the fairgrounds.

Each exhibitor may enter up to 20 items in Open Class.  
Premiums will be paid to all qualified exhibits.

All exhibits are grouped into lots. You must enter exhibits in the appropriate lot, listing it on the entry tag. **Each entry requires 2 copies of the entry tag attached to the entry.** Please obtain entry tags in advance by copying from the back of this book or going online at [www.saunderscountyfair.com](http://www.saunderscountyfair.com) There will be additional tags available at the Open Class check in area.

Any article that has been exhibited previously in 4-H or Open Class is ineligible for entry. Not following the guidelines for your entry may result in the ribbon placing to be dropped lower.

Articles must be made by the individual who exhibits unless noted. **Be sure to write the age of all youth 0 – 18** exhibiting in Open Class and mark the tag Beginners or Juniors. (Age prior to January 1<sup>st</sup> this year.)

Ribbons will be awarded to all entries in each lot. Youth 7 and under (Beginners) will receive participation ribbons and 75¢ premium. Adult exhibits and Youth exhibits 8 to 18 (Juniors) will be judged. Premiums of \$1.25, \$1.00, and 75¢ will be paid. **Youth should list their age on the entry tag.** Ages are prior to January 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year.

One “Best of Lot” ribbon will be awarded in each lot chosen from the entries with \$1 additional premium awarded.

One “Best of Division” ribbon will be awarded in each division chosen from the Best of Lot winners with \$1 additional premium awarded.

The Open Class Building will not be open to the public during judging. Hours open to the public are:

Wednesday, July 27<sup>th</sup> ..... after judging is completed till 9 p.m.

Thursday – Saturday.....9 a.m. – 9 p.m.

Sunday, July 31<sup>st</sup> .....1 p.m. – 4:30 p.m.

Building will be closed from 4:30 – 5:30 p.m. to prepare for release of exhibits on Sunday.

**All exhibits must be removed between 5:30 – 7:00 p.m. on Sunday, July 31st.** Exhibitors are responsible for articles left after 7:00 p.m. Sunday. **NO EXHIBITS MAY BE REMOVED BEFORE 5:30 p.m., SUNDAY.**

The Saunders County Agricultural Society (Fair Board) is not responsible for damage or loss that may occur to exhibits. You may cover items with clear plastic to protect them from soiling.

**\*\*DIVISION 1 – FOODS\*\***

Rolls and cookies are to be placed on a small paper plate. Bread and cakes are to be placed on a large paper plate or suitable size foil covered cardboard. All should be covered with plastic bags. ATTACH ENTRY CARD SECURELY. PLEASE LEAVE RINGS ON JARS – LOOSELY – SO THAT SEALS ARE NOT BROKEN ON LIDS DURING MOVING AND DISPLAYING. Canned, pickled and dried items may be opened for judging. All jellies, jams, pickles, relishes, canned foods, and dried foods should include processing times and methods on a label pasted or taped on the bottom of the jar. Last year's late fall fruit may be used. Not including processing will result in dropping a ribbon placing or not judging, depending on the item judged. *Please tape a copy of the your recipe to the back of your entry.*

**The family of Sylvia Benson will award \$15 to the Best of Division in Foods.**

**LOT 101 – YEAST BREADS** (no mixes)

White Bread, Whole Wheat, Rye, Sourdough, Yeast Rolls, Parkerhouse Rolls, Crescent & Horn Rolls, Buns, and others. Please include half of a loaf or 3 rolls.

**LOT 102 – FANCY YEAST BREADS** (no mixes)

Raisin Bread, Cinnamon Rolls, Kolaches, Braided Yeast Loaf or Ring, or other. Please include half of a loaf or 3 rolls.

**LOT 103 – BREAD MACHINE PRODUCTS**

(Special breads may contain ½ white flour)

White Bread, Whole Wheat, Rye, Herb, Raisin, Fruit, (above need to be baked in bread machine), Machine Dough hard shaped, and others. Please include a full loaf.

**LOT 104 – QUICK BREADS**

(No Yeast Used - No Mixes)

Nut, Coffee Cake, Zucchini, Banana, Cake Doughnuts, Pumpkin, Biscuits, Muffins, Microwaved Quick Bread, and others. Please include half of a loaf or 3 biscuits, etc.

**LOT 105 – COOKIES** (no mixes) *Children may enter cookies in the Jr. Division*

Plain Sugar, Oatmeal, Peanut Butter, Ginger or Molasses, Chocolate Chip, Spritz, Honey, Chocolate, and others. Please include 3 cookies.

**LOT 106 – BARS** (no mixes)

Bars unfrosted, brownies unfrosted, other bars. Please include 3 squares.

**LOT 107 – MISCELLANEOUS BAKED ITEM** (no mixes)

Baked item not listed in lots 104, 105 or 106.

**LOT 108 – CAKES (No Mixes)**

Spice or Applesauce frosted, white yellow or chocolate 2 layer frosted, Bunt, Angel Food unfrosted, Fruit Cake, Oatmeal, Carrot, Jelly Roll, Decorated Cake, Decorated Cookies, Decorated Cup Cakes, and others. Please include ¼ cake.

**LOT 109 – JELLIES** *(made from the juice of the fruit)*

Apple, Chokecherry, Grape, Plum, Elderberry, Gooseberry, Cherry, Strawberry, Apricot, Rhubarb, Raspberry, Peach, and others.

**LOT 110 - JAMS, PRESERVES, & BUTTERS**

Apple Butter, Orange Marmalade, Cherry and others.

**LOT 111 – PICKLES & RELISH**

Dill, Sweet, Beet, Bread & Butter, Watermelon, Sweet Dills, Beans, Green Tomato, Zucchini, Pickle, Corn, Piccalilli, Mixed Vegetable, Zucchini, and others.

**LOT 112 – CANNED FRUITS & VEGETABLES**

(Must be in standard canning jars)

Apples, Apricots, Cherries-red pitted, Bing Cherries, Rhubarb, Peaches-halves, Pears, Plum, Applesauce, Raspberries, Strawberries, Tomatoes, Tomato Juice, Mulberries, Green Beans, Beans-Yellow Wax, Carrots, Sauerkraut (1 yr. or older), Canned Meat, and others.

**LOT 113 - DRIED FOOD**

Dried Fruit, Dried Vegetable, Jerky, Fruit Leather, Noodles, Dried Herbs.

**LOT 114 – HOME & COMMERCIAL PRODUCTS**

Lard-1qt jar home rendered, Wine (1 bottle, 1 yr. or older), Item using a Watkins Product, and others.

**LOT 115 – PIES**

Apple, Cherry, Peach, and Fruit Pie not listed. Please include ¼ pie.

**LOT 116 – CANDY**

Mints, Lollipops or Hard Candy, Fudge, Molded Candy, Covered Candies (Nuts, Cream Centers and Caramels), Divinity, Nut Brittle, Toffee, and others. Please include 6 pieces of one type of candy.

**LOT 117 – HEALTHY SNACKS**

Foods or snacks low in sugar, higher in nutritional value.

**\*\*DIVISION 2 - SEWING, NEEDLEWORK & QUILTING\*\***

Garments, etc. should be clean and pressed if necessary. Embellished or decorated items will be judged for clothing construction if entered in Sewing Division. If you have stamped or painted a purchased clothing item, it can be entered in the Arts and Crafts Division to be judged for artistic design and work. Needlework items should be clean and pressed or blocked if necessary. All items must have been completed in the last 2 years.

**Makovicka Sylliaasen Physical Therapy will give a \$10 award to the winner in the Sewing & Needlework area of this division.**

**LOT 201 – CLOTHING**

Shorts, Simple Top, Dress, Bunting, Slacks, Jumper, Sleepwear, Coat, Costumes, Formal, Holiday or Special Occasion and others.

**LOT 202 – EMBELLISHED & HERITAGE SEWING**

(Identify constructed or purchased garment) Heirloom Garment, Embellished, Garment constructed from originally designed fabric, and others.

**LOT 203 – HOME & INTERIORS**

Tie Comforter, Hot Dish Mats or Pot Holders (2 or 3), Place Mats (set of 4), Pillow, Storage Items, Picture, Soft Sculpture, Basket, Curtains, Crib Layettes, and others.

**LOT 204 – TOYS & STUFF**

Doll Clothes, Stuffed Doll, Stuffed Animal, Toy, Purse or Tote Bag, Recycled Garment, and others.

**LOT 205 – MACHINE APPLIQUE**

Towel, Picture, Garment, Sweatshirt/T-shirt, Place Mat, and others.

**LOT 206 – KNITTING (Hand or Machine)**

Please specify if hand or machine knitted.

Hat, Scarf, Gloves or Mittens, Pillow, Toy, Afghan, Sweater, Vest, Cape, Poncho or Shawl, Bedspread, Tablecloth, Baby Blanket, Dress, and others.

**LOT 207 – CROCHETING**

Hat, Scarf, Gloves or Mittens, Pillow, Toy, Ornament, Wreath, Purse, Pot Holder, Doilies, and others.

**LOT 208 – TATTING**

Tatted Edge, Doily, and others.

**LOT 209 – EMBROIDERY (Hand or Machine)**

Please specify if hand or machine embroidered.

Clothing Item, Pillow Case, Pillow, Towels, Picture, Place Mats (4), Tablecloth, Bedspread, Item for Your Home, and others.

**LOT 210 – CANDLEWICKING**

Clothing Item, Item for Your Home, and others.

**LOT 211 – COUNTED CROSS STITCH**

Clothing Item, Pillow Case, Pillow, Towels, Picture, Place Mats (4), Tablecloth, Bedspread, and others.

**LOT 212 – HARDANGER**

Item for Your Home, and others.

**LOT 213 – NEEDLEPOINT**

Pillow, Picture, Wall Hanging, Picture Frame, and others.

**LOT 214 – HAND APPLIQUE**

Pillow, Wall Hanging, Garment, Place Mats (4), Quilts, Tablecloth, etc.

**LOT 215 – PLASTIC CANVAS**

Wall Hanging, Ornament, Toy, Place Mat, and others.

**LOT 216 – LATCH HOOK**

Rug, Pillow, Picture, and others.

**LOT 217 – NEEDLEPUNCH**

Rug, Pillow, Picture, Garment, and others.

**LOT 218 – WOVEN OR BRAIDED**

Wall Hanging, Place Mats (4), Purse or Tote Bag, Rug, and others.

**LOT 219 – NEEDLEWORK**

Not included above.

**NEBRASKA STATE FAIR “BEST IN COUNTY” NEEDLEWORK CONTEST** The item judged Best of Division in Division 2 shall be eligible for the NE State Fair Best in County Needlework contest. Only one needlework article may be entered in this contest from our county. The exhibitor must reside within our county. Commercial quilting is acceptable. The Open Class Superintendent or County Fair official must sign the “Best in County” pre-entry form. The exhibitor fills out an additional entry form. The exhibits will be governed by the general rules listed in the NE State Fair Needlework Entry Book. See [www.statefair.org](http://www.statefair.org) for rules and the needlework book.

**LOT 230 – QUILTS – OVER 45"**

Hand or Machine Pieced and *Machine* Quilted by the maker.

**LOT 231 - QUILTS – OVER 45"**

Hand or Machine Pieced and *Hand* Quilted by the maker.

**LOT 232 - QUILTS – OVER 45"**

Top made by exhibitor and *quilted commercially* or by one other person.

**LOT 233 – QUILTS – UNDER 45"**

Wallhangings, Baby Quilts, Tablerunners, etc.

Hand or Machine Pieced and *Machine* Quilted by the maker.

**LOT 234 – QUILTS – UNDER 45"**

Wallhangings, Baby Quilts, Tablerunners, etc.

Hand or Machine Pieced and *Hand* Quilted by the maker.

**LOT 235 – QUILTS – UNDER 45"**

Wallhangings, Baby Quilts, Tablerunners, etc.

Top made by exhibitor and *quilted commercially* or by someone else.

**LOT 236 – QUILTED ITEMS**

Pillows, placemats, tablecloth, etc.

**LOT 237 –MULTI –MAKER QUILT**

A quilt made by 2 or more people. This includes progressive, row-by-row, round robin or group quilts. Please include a note about the group that made the quilt.

**LOT 238 - HERITAGE ITEM** Tatting, quilt work, embroidery, quilting, crocheting, painting, etc. The item can be **passed down in your family**, not necessarily made by you.

**LOT 239 - 1<sup>ST</sup> TIME QUILTER** Quilt made by a new quilter. The quilt must be the first quilting project made by the entrant.

**\*\*DIVISION 3 – AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS\*\***

All fruits and/or vegetables must be grown by the exhibitor. Bring three each of all smaller vegetables unless noted. Please wash vegetables and leave stems on, but clipped evenly. ENTRANTS ARE TO BRING DISPLAYS ON THEIR OWN WHITE FOAM TRAY OR HEAVY DUTY PLATE. **Attach 2 copies of the entry tag to the tray or plate before entering. The family of Sylvia Benson will award \$15 to the Best of Division in Agricultural Products.**

**LOT 301 – FRUITS & NUTS**

Apples (please write type on tag), Peaches, Pears, Plums, Grapes (2 bunches) Collection of Fruit, and other. Please include 3 of each fruit.

**LOT 302 – VEGETABLES**

Sweet Corn (3 ears w/ husk not pulled back), Beans (5), Beets (3 w/ 1” stem-unwashed), Broccoli (2 heads), Cabbage (1 head), Cauliflower (1 head), Carrots (3 w/ 1” stem-unwashed), Cherry Tomatoes (6 in a bowl. no stems), Eggplant (2), Garlic (5 bulbs), Kohlrabi (3 w/ 1” stem), Onions (3 w/ 1” stem), Parsnips (3), Peppers (3 w/ 1” stem), Potatoes (3), Rhubarb (3 stalks), Sugar Snap Peas (5), Tomatoes (3 w/ no stem), Turnips (3), Collection of different vegetables (5 or 6), and others.

**LOT 303 – VINE PRODUCTS**

Cantaloupe (1), Muskmelon (1), Cucumbers (3 w/ stems), Gourds (4 or 5), Pumpkin (1), Squash (1), Okra (2), Watermelon (1), Zucchini (1), Collection of Different Vine Products (5 or 6), and others.

**LOT 304 – FRESH HERBS**

Basil, Dill, Mint, Oregano, Parsley, Rosemary, Sage, Thyme, and others. Please include 3 of each.

**LOT 305 – “Just for Fun” JUMBOS**

*Each entry shall contain one vegetable*

Cabbage, Carrot, Corn –one tallest stalk (no roots), Corn –largest ear, Cucumber, Eggplant, Green Bean, Onion, Muskmelon, Potato, Pumpkin, Squash, Sunflower –largest (head only), Tomato, Watermelon, Zucchini, and others.

**LOT 306 – SEED & STALK**

**Jar** of Winter Wheat, Soybeans, Oats, Milo, Corn, Shelled Corn, Popcorn or Sunflower Seeds from a 2009 or 2010 crop.

**Stalks** - 3 Stalk Display tied together cut at ground level (no roots) of Corn, Sweet Corn, Soybeans or Tame Sunflowers with heads. Note – Do not pull back the husks on the ears of corn. **Specify whether it is dry land or irrigated on the tag.**

***(Exhibitors must pick up stalk displays on Sunday evening when exhibits are released.)***

**\*\*DIVISION 4 – FLORICULTURE\*\***

All flowers must be grown by the exhibitor. In the cut flowers, flowers may be exhibited in any appropriate container, but the container will not be judged. **Please remove all foliage below the water line of the container.** (Entries will be downgraded a ribbon placing if the instructions are not followed.)

Cut flowers shall contain 3 flowers or one spray of flowers.

**The family of Sylvia Benson will award \$15 to the Best of Division in Floriculture.**

**LOT 401 – ARTISTIC AND FLOWER ARRANGEMENTS**

Fresh Cut Arrangement, Wildflower Arrangement, Dried Arrangement.  
(Cut flowers, foliage and container are all included in the judging.)

**LOT 402 – CUT FLOWERS**

Dahlia, Daisies, Dianthus, Gallardia, Gladiolus, Hemerocallis or Day Lilies, Lily, Impatiens, Marigold, Nasturtiums, Pansies, Petunia, Phlox, Rose, Salvia, Snapdragons, Vinca, Zinnia, and others.

**Please include 3 flowers or one spray.**

**LOT 403 – POTTED PLANTS**

African Violet, Begonia, Cactus, Fern, Geranium, Hoya, Ivy, Philodendron, Schifflera, Succulent, Wandering Jew, Herbs, Hanging Plant, and others.

**\*\*DIVISION 5 – ARTS & CRAFTS, \*\***

Framed artwork, paintings, and photography need to be equipped to hang (Arts & Crafts division only). All items should have been completed since last years fair.

**LOT 501 – LEADED STAINED GLASS**

Large Item, Small Item, and others.

**LOT 502 – WOOD ART**

Wood Burned Picture or Object, Wood Carved Picture or Object, Tole or Decorative Painting on Wood, and others.

**LOT 503 – CHINA PAINTING, TOLE PAINTING**

China Painted (doll, jewelry, or other), Tole or Decorative Painting (other than wood), and others.

**LOT 504 – CERAMICS, POTTERY, PLASTER**

Ceramic: Stained, Overglazed, Underglazed, Glaze and Stain Combination, Air Brushed, Luster and Metallic, Added Decoration, Special Techniques (specify on entry tag), Pottery: Hand Built, Wheel Thrown, Painted, and others.

**LOT 505 – PICTURES**

*(All pictures should be originals. All unframed pictures must be mounted on a firm backing. Please do not bring framed pictures with glass.)*

Pencil, Ink, Print, Crayon, Chalk, Pastel, Charcoal, Tole–decorative painting, Water Color, Oil or Acrylic, and others.

**LOT 506 – FABRIC CRAFT**

Padded Album, Padded –other, Ornament, Soft Sculpture, Fabric Sculpture, Wall Hanging, Primitive Fabric Art, and others.

**LOT 507 – HANDCRAFTS**

Paper Ribbon, Jewelry, Bread Dough, Bead/Sequin, Quilting, Flower –handmade, Plastic –any type or method, Toy or Game –handmade, Decoupaged Item or Picture, Pine Cone Nut or Seed Item, Corn Husk or Wheat Weaving, Tin Punch, Sculpture (not metal), Paint by number, kit, or others.

**LOT 508 – EMBELLISHED (Decorated) READY-TO-WEAR**

*(Garment may be ready-made or purchased. Judging on embellishments only.)*

3-Dimensional, Stenciled, Free Hand Painted or Sponged, Appliquéd w/ Paint, Accessories, Embellished (w/ lace, Yo Yo's, Buttons, etc.), or other.

**LOT 509 – SEASONAL CRAFTS**

Wreath, Wall Decoration, Decorative Fan or Broom, Ornament, Table Top Decor, Item w/ Potpourri or Dried Flowers, Tree Skirt, Door Décor, Floor or Hearth Decoration, and others.

**LOT 510 – HOLIDAY CRAFTS**

*(Wreaths, wall décor, centerpieces, etc.)*

Valentine, Easter, 4<sup>th</sup> of July, Halloween, Thanksgiving, Christmas, and Holiday not listed.

**LOT 511 – BASKETS**

Reed, Handmade, Covered, Decorated –Purchased, Decorated –Handmade, Wall Decoration, and others.

**LOT 512 – RECYCLED & REUSED**

New Item made from Old Item, Item to use in the Sorting & Recycling Efforts around the House, or other. Attach a card explaining your project.

**LOT 513 – MINIATURES & MODELS**

Miniatures for dollhouse, Model Type Miniature, and others.

**LOT 514 – SCRAPBOOKING – 1 or 2 Page Layout**

Baby/Child, Special Occasion, Wedding, Anniversary, Graduation, Family, and Misc.

**LOT 515 – SCRAPBOOKING – FULL BOOK**

Same as above.

**LOT 516 – YARD ART**

Wooden, Metal, Decorated container/ Plant, Clay/Concrete/Ceramic, or other.

**\*\*DIVISION 6 - PHOTOGRAPHY \*\***

**Amateur Photographers only please (no professional photography)**

Youth prints shall be between 4 x 6 and 8 x 10 inches and be entered in Lots 600 & 601. Youth entries must have the youth's age on the entry tag.

Adult Prints shall be 5 x 7, 8 x 10, or 11 x 14 inches.

Photos may be color or black and white.

All photos must have a hard backing and can be matted. Please no frames.

Any original exposure modified other than cropping or minor touch up must be entered in Lot 603 Photo Manipulation or it maybe disqualified.

All photos must have name, address, lot #, location, age if needed, and title of photo listed on the entry tag or the back of the photo.

**LIMIT OF 10 ENTRIES PER EXHIBITOR IN THIS DIVISION**

\$10 to the winner of the Photography Division.**

**LOT 600 – YOUTH PHOTOGRAPHY - AGE THROUGH 10 YEARS**

Open subject matter – Photo must have been taken by the entrant age 10 and under.

**LOT 601 – YOUTH PHOTOGRAPHY - AGES 11 – 18**

Open subject matter – Photo must have been taken by the entrant age 11 through 18.

## **LOT 602 – EXHIBIT PRINT**

All rules above apply to this category.

**Sub Lot 602A: People / Portraits**

**Sub Lot 602B: Animals & Nature – Plants, flowers, insects, animals**

**Sub Lot 602C: Scenery / Landscapes**

**Sub Lot 602D: Human Interest – Occupations, Candid Shots**

## **LOT 603 – PHOTO MANIPULATION**

Demonstrate your creativity by changing or altering a photo in a significant way (more than simple editing.) Photos must follow all the previously listed rules except that anything can be manipulated in your print.

## **LOT 604 – SAUNDERS COUNTY THEME EXHIBIT**

For 2011 the Theme is “*Saunders County at It's Best*”. Use your own definition of the theme title. Tape an explanation to your exhibit.

## **LOT 605 – SAUNDERS COUNTY EXHIBITION PRINT**

Photo depiction promoting or exemplifying Saunders County, Nebraska, it's people, it's surroundings, or as a great place to visit as a county. Image must be taken in Saunders County and location must be identified on the back of the exhibit.

## **LOT 606 – PANORAMA**

A panoramic print.
